

Covid-19: Vital functions and minimum activity maintenance for Observatoire de Paris.

Note updated March 15, 2020.

By vital function is meant a function that cannot be interrupted without serious consequences for the personnel, real or movable property or for the accomplishment of the regalian missions of the establishment.

These functions include managing staff pay (DRH and Agence Comptable), maintaining the security and safety of sites and premises (DIL), basic maintenance of installations (electricity, heating) (DIL), maintenance of the Observatory's computer servers (DIO) and certain departments, provision of legal time (SYRTE).

During the closure of the establishment, as of Monday, March 16 and until further notice:

-Most of the vital functions can be performed remotely, by teleworking staff. This mode of operation is to be preferred.

-Vital functions that cannot be performed remotely require the presence of some staff on site. The list of these personnel and the frequency of their presence on site have been established and will be checked and completed by Monday 16 March, 2020.
